
DANCEWEAR REQUIREMENTS

Purchase dancewear from **Dance Outfitters** in **Chesapeake**, **VA**, ensuring proper attire for each age group.

Pre-Dance (ages 2-6): Pink leotard, pink tights, pink ballet slippers, tan U shell tap.

Workshop Company (ages 7-10): Black leotard, black tights, pink ballet slippers, tan U shell tap.

Company (ages 8+): Black leotard, black tights, pink canvas ballet shoes, black string-up tap, tan slip-on.

Summer Intensives are \$50/month.



STAFFING ROLES



Site Directors: Manage daily operations of the facility, including supervising staff and teachers, ensuring timely opening and closing of the studio, and maintaining a positive, inclusive atmosphere.

Master Teachers: Provide specialized training and advanced classes at \$25/hour, helping students further their technique.

Alumni Teachers: Former students who return to teach classes or assist, helping to build a sense of community and mentorship within the dance family.

Student Teachers: Middle and high school students with advanced training, offered free tuition in exchange for teaching assistance.



Parent Liaison: Assists with communication, addresses parent concerns, and encourages student practice and participation.

Parent Expectations

Attend the mandatory parent meeting at the start of the season to address any questions.

Ensure timely drop-off and pickup of students to avoid late fees.

Parents are not permitted in the studio during classes or rehearsals.

No food or drink is allowed inside the studio.

Encourage practice at home.

Review studio policies with children to help them understand the importance of following rules.

Student Expectations

Arrive on time and come prepared for class with the necessary dancewear and accessories.

Pay attention, listen to instructors, and respect the class etiquette.

Practice good hygiene and keep the studio clean.

Stay positive, enjoy the class, and focus on personal growth.



PAYMENT STRUCTURE

Parents are expected to make timely payments for tuition, summer camps, and intensives.

Accounts will incur a late fee of \$25.00 if payments are overdue.

All payment arrangements must be made in advance, and the staff will assist families with any financial concerns.
